(Funding for Anime Spot to host the Knightrokon Convention on March 3, 2012)

.01 **WHEREAS**, Anime Spot has been a registered student organization since 2006;
 .02 **WHEREAS**, The mission of Anime Spot is to spread their influence on the positive aspects of anime and manga;
 .03 Anime Spot wants to help others understand the difference between the animation styles of different countries focused
 .04 around Japan, Korea, and America; Anime Spot will take a step into the exploration of historical and cultural aspects
 .05 of anime in Japan;
 .06 **WHEREAS**, Anime Spot currently has 200 Active members;
 .07 **WHEREAS**, Anime Spot will be fundraising by hosting a series of Cosplay car washes, Selling T-Shirts, Membership
 .08 cards, Selling Japanese snacks, Selling donated anime/manga, and donation raffles;
 .09 **WHEREAS**, The Knightrokon Convention is aimed at providing a fun convention atmosphere for UCF students and
 .10 the convention community alike by running quality anime-themed events and bringing the UCF community together,
 .11 from vendors and artists to panelists and fans who just want to have fun;
 .12 **WHEREAS**, It will bring a part of anime/nerd/niche culture to UCF that it has not had since 2002, when JACON left
 .13 UCF. JACON was an anime convention that took place from 2000-2010 and started out in the Student Union; It was
 .14 run by the university's anime club at the time and was hugely successful;
 .15 **WHEREAS**, Anime Spot will be able to bring industry guests who can help students get into the acting and anime
 .16 industries and also give UCF more credibility in this part of the market;
 .17 **WHEREAS**, Anime Spot is allowing people who come to donate to Knights Pantry in exchange for special benefits
 .18 during the convention;
 .19 **WHEREAS**, Every UCF student will be able to get into the convention for free, so this will expose students who are
 .20 into this sort of thing and students who are not to a unique culture that some of them may not have known about;
 .21 **WHEREAS**, UCF students are allowed free half-tables for artist alley, where they can sell their art and possibly make
 .22 connections in the art industry; The price for another half a table is only \$15, which is more than competitive in the
 .23 convention industry;
 .24 **WHEREAS**, Students will have the chance to meet with members of the Florida convention community, since we will
 .25 have free tables for local clubs and conventions;
 .26 **WHEREAS**, Students will have the opportunity to run panels or workshops about their own interests; Those who do
 .27 not want to run panels will be able to attend them;
 .28 **WHEREAS**, Anime Spot will be putting on a few panels and events which will be going on for most of the day, and
 .29 all of them will be free for students to attend, aside from the VIP event for Anime Spot members;
 .30 **WHEREAS**, Anime Spot members will have early access to main events and the vendor room, as well as a VIP event
 .31 that we will be discussing with the industry guests;
 .32 **WHEREAS**, Student organizations will have the opportunity to table at this event on a first come, first served basis;
 .33 **WHEREAS**, The Knightrokon Convention will take place on March 3rd, 2012 in the UCF Student Union; and
 .34 **WHEREAS**, Anime Spot received \$0.00 in the 2011-2012 Activity and Service Fee Budget and \$400.00 through FAO
 .35 Allocation 43-082;

 .38 *Enacted*, by the Forty-Fourth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$7,911.00 be allocated to Anime


.68 **BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, That no funds be spent on Websites, Thumbtacks, Key West Ballroom, Programs,
