

TITLE II: STUDENT GOVERNMENT STATUTORY DEFINITIONS AND PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY

Chapter 200 Parliamentary Authority

- 200.1 The Student Government parliamentary authority shall be the current edition of Robert's Rules of Order.
- 200.2 Robert's Rules of Order shall be the authority for all formal and announced Student Government meetings.
- 200.3 Robert's Rules of Order shall be the authority only over those questions which have not been specified by general law or university regulations or by the Constitution of the Student Body of the University of Central Florida, Student Body Statutes or Senate Rules and Procedures.

Chapter 201 Statutory Definitions

- 201.1 The current edition of Black's Law Dictionary shall be used in understanding the terms contained within the Student Body Statutes not otherwise defined in Statutes.
- 201.2 Any question regarding the interpretation or explanation of terms within Student Body Statutes shall be answered by the Attorney General.
- 201.3 The following terms shall be defined in the Student Body Statutes as follows:

2/3-Twice as many "for" than "against."

Censure-An official reprimand or condemnation.

Corruption -Violation of any provision in the Golden Rule, Student Body Constitution, or Student Body Statutes.

Ex-Officio Member- A formally unrecognized member of a board, committee, or entity, invited to sit on the board, committee, or entity by means of official legislation or invitation by an authorized member. Ex-Officio Members have no voting rights.

Majority-More than fifty percent (50%).

No-Confidence-Lack or absence of confidence in a leader within the Senate.

Non-Compliance-Absence or inaction of performance on a specific duty required by the Student Body Constitution, Student Body Statutes, Senate Rules, Senate Bills, and/or other legal mandates.

Property-All physical and electronic materials that are in any way managed by the Student Government Association or are purchased or maintained through the Activity and Service Fee.

Student Government Association Affiliated Services - An Activity and Service Fee entity of the Student Government Association, adopted and/or created to provide campus activities, student support, education, and leadership opportunities and/or created to maintain Activity and Service Fee funded facilities.

- A. Any Student Government Association Affiliated Service that is primarily run by a Student Director under the supervision of an A&SF funded staff advisor shall be known as a “Student Government Association Affiliated Service.”
- B. Any Student Government Association Affiliated Service that is primarily run by an Administrative Director shall be known as a “Student Government Association Affiliated Department.”

Student Government Agent - Any student position that is specifically stated in the Student Body Statutes (e.g., President, Vice President, Judicial Council Member, Senator), that holds the position of Student Director of an Agency, or is compensated through the Activity & Service Fee Budget Other Personnel Service (OPS) line-item of:

- A. Student Government: Executive
- B. Student Government: Legislative
- C. Student Government: Judicial
- D. Student Government: Election Commission
- E. Student Government: Southern Region Campus
- F. Student Government: Eastern Region Campus
- G. Student Government: A&SF Committee

Student Government Staff-All A&SF Funded personnel, not specified to be a Student Government Agent, who are considered University Support Personnel System (USPS) staff or Administrative and Professional (A&P) staff working for or on behalf of the Student Government Association.
